Board of Management

The BOM met and discussed our recent school closures in relation to the DES circular. DES Circular 0009/2017- Guidance for schools in relation to making up for time lost due to unforeseen school closures is included at Appendix B of this circular. This guidance sets out a structured approach to determining the measures to be put in place to make up for time lost. The guidance provides that subject to consensus at local level, any changes to normal practice that can be made to address the shortfalls should be put in place.

The Board met to look at the options outlined to make up tuition time including—cancelling school tours / cancelling sports day and music day / opening days at easter holidays.

Following feedback from Parents Association , staff and pupils the school has planned to make up lost tuition time to core subject areas through -

- School will prioritises Tuition time By using its Discretionary Teaching Time allowed to schools / roll Call time/ Assembly time each day
- Cancel Travelling Theatre / Fred the clown
- School will Not take The 2nd Half day Allowed For Child Protection Training- and will Conduct the staff training after 3pm instead
